	Successfully complete ENGL 101, MATH 102 and SPCM 101 with a grade of "C" or better.
	<b>Take one course that meets the Global Issues Requirement ( *) and one course that meets the Written Communications Requirement (**).</b>
	Complete paperwork to declare any minors.
	<b>Pre-Professional Block Requirements</b>
	Successfully complete the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators exams.
	Complete 30 hours of community services.
	Complete SPED 100, EDFN 338, EPSY 302 with a grade of "C" or better.
	Complete Disposition Survey (in SPED 100).
